East Troy Lights returns to square for entire month

Take a trip to downtown East Troy this December to see East Troy Lights – a spectacular holiday light show.

The interactive and imaginative light display experience will kick off Saturday, Dec. 3, when Santa comes to East Troy via the 114-year-old East Troy Electric Railroad Santa Parade Train to light the annual Bob Barutha Memorial Christmas Tree.

Lights will continue with timed shows on the hour at 5 p.m., 6 p.m., 7 p.m. and 8 p.m. through Dec. 31. Walk through the lights or see the show from your car by tuning into 90.9 FM.

“Watch as the entire downtown East Troy Square sparkles in the night in sync with your favorite holiday songs. Or, take control of the lights yourself and create your own holiday magic,” said Vanessa Lenz, Executive Director, East Troy Area Chamber of Commerce.

The foundation of the project is collaboration with the East Troy Community School District (from 4K to 12), East Troy’s businesses, attractions and residents coming together to make it happen.

working with students to build the interactive light show boxes, their efforts have been remarkable,” Lenz said.

Several area businesses and organizations, along with volunteers and donors, are working together to create this unique event to draw visitors to the area, including presenting partners Sauced Pizzeria, Allan Integrated Control Systems, East Troy Brewery and East Troy Community School District.

While the show takes place primarily outdoors, there will be options to get inside the historic spaces and attractions on the square.

“We’re thrilled to bring back this magical attraction for people of all ages to enjoy the most wonderful time of the year in East Troy,” Lenz said. “We’re planning for more lights, more interactivity, more activities and more holiday magic in 2022.”

Santa Claus is coming to town Dec. 3

Santa Claus, Mrs. Claus and their entourage will kick off the holiday season in East Troy on Saturday, Dec. 3 via the East Troy Electric Railroad’s Santa Train.

The beautifully lit four-car train will travel down the century-old interurban trolley line between Mukwonago and East Troy, leaving the Elegant Farmer at 5:06 p.m. and arriving at Division Street in East Troy at 6:25 p.m., with brief stops at crossings along the way. 1. Hit the slopes at Alpine Valley Resort

2. See the Santa Parade Train

The East Troy Electric Railroad’s Santa Parade Train will make its annual journey into downtown East Troy on Saturday, Dec. 3. Presented by the East Troy Electric Railroad in conjunction with the East Troy Area Chamber of Commerce and Mukwonago Area Chamber of Commerce and Tourism Center, the beautifully lit four-car train will travel down the century-old interurban trolley line between Mukwonago and East Troy. The original East Troy Christmas Parade train, started by the East Troy Jaycees and the railroad in 1972, was a historic reproduction of the Schuster’s Christmas Parade in Milwaukee. The Schuster’s Department store chain sponsored the parade, established in 1928, to kick off the Christmas shopping season. It disappeared in 1955 with the demise of the Milwaukee Electric Lines interurban and streetcar system. Spectators can catch a glimpse of Santa along County Road ES. The train will slow briefly at the following crossings*:

- 5:06 p.m., train departs at The Elegant Farmer
- 5:25 p.m., N. Army Lake Road – Army Lake Camp
- 5:42 p.m., Army Lake Camp
- 5:56 p.m., St. Peter’s Road
- 6:13 p.m., Byrnes Street
- 6:25 p.m., Division Street
- 6:30 p.m., Santa arrives at East Troy Village Square Park via East Troy Fire Department truck to light the Bob Barutha Memorial Christmas Tree & debut of East Troy Lights.

Best Way to Give Back

SUPPORT HOLIDAY HELP PROGRAM THIS WINTER

The Holiday Help of East Troy program will continue this year featuring a collaborative approach to assisting local families in need. Local charities are getting a kick start on holiday donations, to make sure they have enough resources to help this holiday season. "It is through the generous support of local businesses, churches, organizations and community members that this program is able to continue," said East Troy Family and Community Resource Center coordinator Marolyn Komperud, who leads the nine-year-old initiative. Komperud said the community partnership program model makes it easier than ever to provide families in need with gifts, winter clothing and a holiday meal during the holiday season. In 2021, Holiday Help of East Troy served 78 families with a combined 184 children from the East Troy Community School District boundaries. Here are ways to give this year. 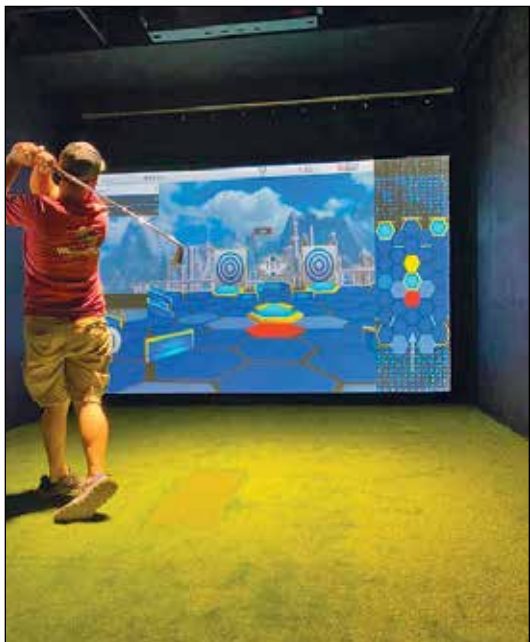
At Wisconsin Fairways, you swing your real clubs and hit real balls from the tee box to the pin.

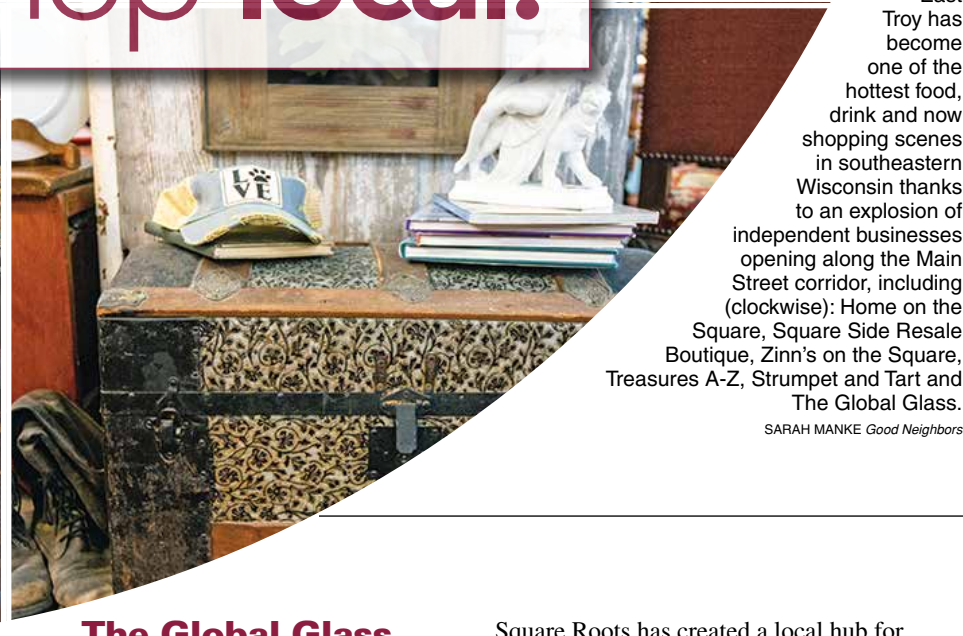

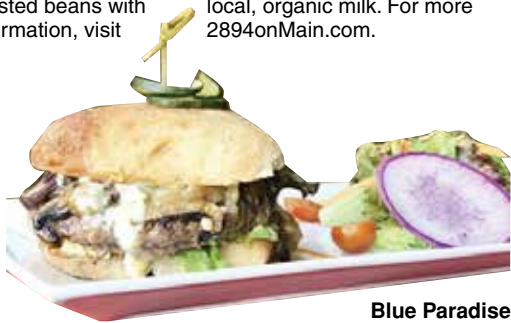
